HOW TO FILE AN ELECTION COMPLAINT

- -To file a complaint go to the Student Activities Office on the second floor of the Husky Union Building
- -SAO will provide complaint forms which require a complete description of the violation and the name and/or characteristics of the people involved
- -If you have a photograph showing the violation please submit it with your complaint
- -Complaints can be filed against candidates the proponents or opponents of ballot measures, volunteers, and the Elections Administration Committee
- -Complaints must be filed by 5:00PM on May 17th.

COMMON ELECTION VIOLATIONS

- -Bribing or threatening voters
- -Tampering with election material
- -Handing out food or drink by any elections participants
- -Elections participants instructing voters to "vote for" or "not vote for" a candidate or ballot measure
- -Campaigning within 100 feet of an EAC voting table
- -Active campaigning in UW buildings or Residence Halls
